

The Sinai Peninsula in Egypt spans across two continents, Africa and Asia. Mount Catherine is the highest mountain in Egypt, The official language of Egypt is Arabic, but others languages such as English and French are also understood by many.. The longest river in the world, the Nile, runs through Egypt.

A pyramid is a structure, mostly of stone, built in the shape of a pyramid. From ancient to modern times, people in many different parts of the world have built such structures.

In Egypt, kings and queens, called Pharaohs, were buried in huge square-bottomed pyramids built of stone. Also they are tombs of queens and kings. Pyramids were built by slaves. The most important pyramids are Kefren, Keops, Mikerinos

and Giza. Pyramids are closer to the Nile.

Many of pyramids still survive today for us to see and explore. There are around 138 Egyptian pyramids. They were over 480 feet tall. They were the tallest manmade structure for over 3800 years. For built one pyramid, slaves used 2,3 million blocks of rock weighting 5,9 million tons.

They tried to search the history of seven wonders, the unique wonder still surviving is Cheops Pyramid located in Egypt, Giza City. Cheops Pyramid was constructed on behalf of pharaoh Khufu as memorial tomb which is the oldest and the biggest one of pyramids in Egypt.

selbst in der Nazizeit: Die braunen Propagandisten hatten den Sport zum Kult erhoben, um die deutsche Jugend fit zu machen für Hitlers Kriege.

Dann, nach dem Krieg, hassten sich die Geschwister plötzlich. Rudi, erzählte man, sei sauer gewesen, weil er in den Krieg ziehen musste, während Adi die Hausmacht in der Fabrik

ausbaute. Adi, ebenfalls stinksauer, rührte keinen Finger, um seinen Bruder aus der amerikanischen Gefangenschaft zu befreien. With a camera mounted below the trunk lid and a monitor in the dash, these early systems saved lives and made parking far easier for thousands of car owners.

Today the Bluetooth technology is in just about every car and installed on just about every cell phone. To legally talk on your phone in the car in at least 14 states, a hands-free connection must be established between the phone and the car. And Bluetooth is the way to make that happen.

Electronic stability control (ESC), which helps

correct a skid if your car begins to slide, was the final step in a technical progression that began with anti-lock brakes in the 1970s and 1980s.

Big improvements in tire technology had a lot to do with it, and run-flat tires have enjoyed a spike in popularity over the past two decades. But the standardization of tire pressure monitoring systems (TPMS) in cars means that owners are warned about their under-inflated tires before real trouble happens.

INGREDIENTS

You will need 38×38 cm.baking tray,bases lined with baking parchment.

FOR THE TRILEÇE CAKE BATTER:

- 8 eggs
- 1 cup granulated sugar
- 2 packet baking powder, (or 2 tsp or 10 gr.)
- 12 tablespoons heaped all purpose flour, sifted. (12 tbsp heaped all purpose flour=2 cup=280gr.)

FOR THE MILK SAUCE:

- 400 ml. heavy cream (2 cups milk)
- 600ml. whole warm milk (3 cups milk)



500ml. whole cold milk(2,5 cups milk)

- 250gr milk powder
- 5 tablespoons granulated sugar (or 90gr. granulated sugar.)

FOR THE CARAMEL SAUCE:

- 5 tbsp granulated sugar (or 90gr. Granulated sugar.)(or 1/2 cup granulated sugar.)
- 2 tsp margarine, room temperature. (or 50gr.margarine)
- 150ml heavy cream or 1/2 cup hot water.

Place the sugar in a pan, cook until melted the sugar and add the heavy cream then immediately beat them until solve

the sugar, cook it a little thicken, remove it from the heat and add the butter, beat them together until well corporate. Let it warm.

Be careful working with hot sugar.

DIRECTIONS

Heat oven to 170C/ 175C.

MAKING THE CAKE:

1 - Divide the yolks from the egg whites and place the egg whites, the sugar in a big bowl, whisk the whites with a hand mixer until stiff peaks. Add the egg yolks one at time, beating well and then the addition of each.

2- Sift together the flour and baking powder and add to the egg mixture, add the vanilla extract in the mixture.



Beat them about 1 minute. Pour the mixture in a greased and floured cake pan. Bake until golden about 25-30 minutes.

Checking it with a toothpick and remove the cake from the oven and let it cool.

TO MAKE THE MILK SAUCE:

Combine the cold milk and milk powder in a bowl and mix them and add the warm milk, beat until fluffy, add the sugar, beat them again, beating well after add the heavy cream then mix together them and set aside.

3- Pierce the cooled cake with a fork or with a toothpick completely. Drizzle the milk sauce or pour slowly over surface cake. Place the cake in the refrigerate and let it stay 6 hours for soaked well.

For serving: Remove cake from the refrigerate and spread a thin layer of caramel sauce with a spatula. If you deserve decorate it with a little cream. Cut cake in a small squares and serve it.

- 400 gr. Savoiardi (sponge fingers)
 - 4 eggs, separated
 - 4 spoons of sugar
- 1 big pot of strong coffee, preferably espresso
 - 500 gr.

Mascarpone cheese

- pinch of salt
- cocoa powder
- a square serving dish with high sides

PREPARATION:

Prepare the coffee and let it cool down.

Separate the yolks from the whites.

In clean bowl whisk with an electric whisker or a hand whisk the yolks with the sugar until light and pale.

Add the mascarpone cheese e mix still using the whisker.

In another clean bowl whisk the whites with a pinch of salt until stiff.

Gently fold the whites into the mixture of Mascarpone using a metal spoon, do not stir, just gently fold in.

Now start to assemble the dessert.

Place a couple of spoon of the Mascarpone cream at the bottom of your serving dish and spread it well (this will make it easier to remove the slices of Tiramisu when cooled).

Dip each savoiardi biscuit in the coffee quickly, but don't keep them in the coffee long. If you dip them long, they will get soggy. If you dip them too short, they will be dry.

Place the savoiardi next to each other, tightly packed and cover all the base of the dessert dish.

Now place half the mixture on top and spread it well.

Cover with another layer of

soaked savoiardi and cover with the remaining cream. Cover with cling film.

Place in the refrigerator for at least 4 hours. Just before serving sprinkle with cocoa powder.

INGREDIENTS

- 1 box of chocolate cake mix
- 2 boxes of chocolate pudding mix
- Whipped cream
- Eggs, milk, water as called for by the cake and pudding mix directions
 - Powdered sugar
 - Desired decorative bits

Step 1

Prepare the cake according to the box directions. Cover with tinfoil and set aside.

Step 2

Prepare the puddings in the same mixing bowl, following the box directions. Set in the fridge.

Step 3

Place the trifle dish, large tablespoon, whipped cream, decorative extras and prepared layer materials on the table.

Step 4

Cut the cake into 1-inch (2.5 cm) cubes. This will make it easier to use cake for layers

Step 5

Begin with a bottom layer of cake, roughly 1 to 1.5 inches thick. Keep the layers of cake, pudding and whipped cream as even, neat and consistent as possible.

Repeat that step for total of three layers

Step 6

Smooth the remaining whipped cream to form the final top layer of the trifle. Decorate it to match the theme of your event (optional).

- 1/2 teaspoon dried parsley


DIRECTIONS

- Preheat oven to 350 degrees F (175 degrees C).
- 2-Sprinkle chicken breasts with salt and pepper to taste, and place in a lightly greased 9x13 inch baking dish. In a small bowl, combine the honey, mustard, basil, paprika, and parsley. Mix well. Pour 1/2 of this mixture over the chicken, and brush to cover.
- 3- Bake in the preheated oven for 30 minutes. Turn chicken pieces over and brush with the remaining 1/2 of the honey mustard mixture. Bake for an additional 10 to 15 minutes, or until chicken is no longer pink and juices run clear. Let cool 10 minutes before serving.








